2023 Prom Rules

- 1. Prom is an SCHS event and therefore all SCHS policies and procedures apply.
- 2. Prom is a privilege not a guarantee. Outside school discipline and behavior will be taken into consideration before permission is granted to attend prom.
- 3. Juniors and Seniors may bring a guest.
 - a. Guests cannot be family members.
 - b. All non SCHS guests are required to provide a valid photo ID before a ticket will be sold.
 - c. All non SCHS guests are required to fill out a separate form and obtain a reference from a non-family member along with a phone number.
 - d. If your guest is NOT a student of SCHS **or** a 9th or 10th grader at SCHS then you must arrive and leave at the same time.
 - e. SCHS Juniors and Seniors are responsible for their guests.
- 4. **All** prom goers must be pre-approved prior to purchasing a ticket for prom.
- 5. You cannot be chronically absent to attend prom missing more than 15 days of school.
- 6. You cannot have major discipline referrals on your current school record.
- 7. No person under the 9th grade or older than 20 will be allowed to attend the SCHS Prom.
- 8. Students will be in formal attire. Nothing overly revealing, shorts, jeans, or casual clothing will be permitted.
- 9. Any student suspected of entering the prom under the influence of illegal intoxicants, will not be permitted. First, a parent will be called. Second, the SRO will conduct a more thorough investigation. If deemed necessary, the student or students will be turned over to the local authorities and then disciplined at school on the following school day.
- 10. Once students enter the prom, you cannot leave and then return.
- 11. No prom tickets will be sold at the door.
- 12. If you have been in alternative school during the school year, you will not be allowed to attend prom.
